



LESSON 10: HOW TO INITIATE A DESIGN CERTIFICATION RENEWAL



DESIGN CERTIFICATION RENEWAL

GS4GG and CDM have different crediting cycles. For design certification renewal, GS4GG operates on a 5-year cycle that can be renewed twice, while CDM follows a 7-year cycle that can also be renewed twice or remain fixed at 10 years.

When transitioning projects from CDM or GS-CER to GS4GG (GS-VER), it is essential to adhere to the rules and requirements outlined under the GHG Emissions Reduction & Sequestration Product Requirements.

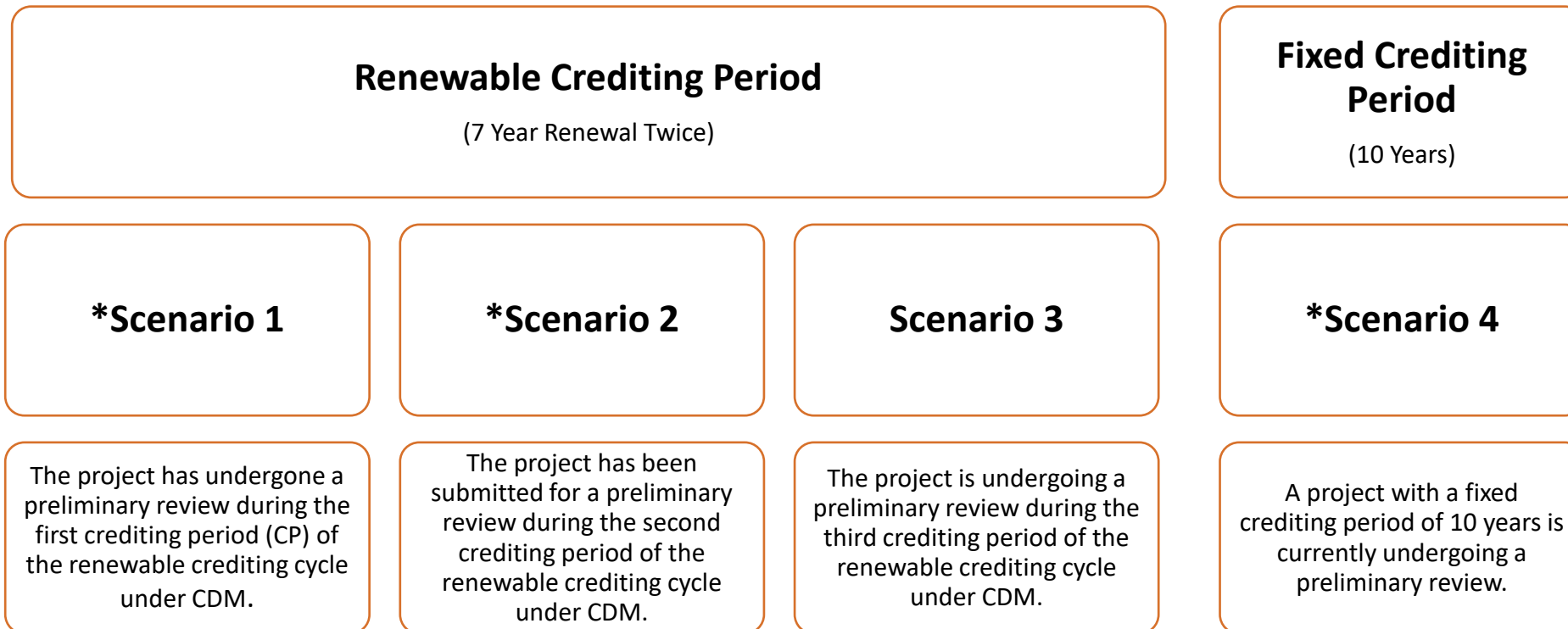

** The requirements for renewing the crediting period depend on the project's certification status during the certification cycle at the moment of submitting the preliminary review.*
